1. Preschool Advantage provides financial assistance for a HALF DAY preschool program for three- and four-year-olds from September through June. When your child reaches five years of age or qualifies for public school prekindergarten and kindergarten, he/she will no longer be eligible for Preschool Advantage assistance.
2. If the child is selected for inclusion in any other program offering preschool tuition assistance, including but not limited to Head Start, the child is no longer eligible for assistance from Preschool Advantage and the parents/guardians must notify Preschool Advantage immediately so that the space may be offered to another child on the waiting list.
3. Preschool Advantage funds attendance only for half-day programs. In the event the child attends a school that offers a full-day program or an aftercare program, and the parent/guardian opts to enroll the child for additional hours, the parent/guardian is responsible for any associated fee(s) beyond the half-day program.
4. Parent/guardian will be responsible for providing transportation to and from school.
5. Parent/guardian will abide by all guidelines, rules and policies of the selected preschool.
6. Child must attend school regularly except for excused illness. Absences of more than 2 weeks in duration, may result in Preschool Advantage ending its assistance for the child.
7. Parent/guardian must attend Preschool Advantage orientation.
8. Parent/guardian must sign a disclaimer form releasing Preschool Advantage from any liability.
9. Upon acceptance by Preschool Advantage and the preschool, the parent/guardian **must pay a \$75.00 registration fee** to Preschool Advantage.
